So, we're going to change things up for the summer and keep our communion servers on floor level at all times! We hope this will make it more accessible for anyone who wants to serve communion to be able to do so. We will begin with this change Sunday, June 8th.

### HELP US UPDATE IMMANUEL'S PROPERTY

It's time for some long-overdue updates to our facilities. Property chair, Stephanie Drange, has done a wonderful job organizing contractors and projects. And we are ready to get stuff done this summer. Here is what is planned: about \$90,000 of "Phase One" – 1) Sanctuary carpet, lighting, and paint 2) New windows and redoing the parking lot. "Second Mile" projects totaling about \$27,000 – 1) Replacing the sanctuary projector and screen with high-definition televisions 2) New kitchen counters and cabinet doors 3) Painting the rest of the upstairs walls. Church council has identified \$80,000 –90,000 of existing money to get started right away. We invite you to help us cross the finish line with the rest.
