


# IMMANUEL HOUSE CHURCH

## At A Glance: What You Need To Know.



### A CENTURIES OLD IDEA

Biblically grounded in discipleship, the concepts of House Church are as old as the church itself. The Immanuel House Church is modeled after a time when followers of Christ would gather in one another's home for prayer, fellowship and Holy Communion.



### A SPIRITUAL HUB

House Churches consisting of 2-4 households will make it possible for regular, safe, faith-filled gatherings of friends and neighbors, where God's Word and Holy Communion can be shared many, many times over the next months.

### VARIETY IS KEY

Every House Church will be as different as the people who form them.

Typically, House Churches will gather once a month for prayer, confession and forgiveness, and to share communion together in homes, patios, garages at a local park or perhaps even gathering online using Zoom.

### SANCTUARY WORSHIP

All House Church participants will have an opportunity to gather for worship in the sanctuary every 4-6 weeks. We will pray a blessing on your House Church, and send you home with communion supplies and resources for your Worship time together.

We're also exploring the possibility of occasional drive-up services.

### IMMANUEL HOME CHURCHES FORMING NOW

Soon we hope to have enough House Churches launched to begin in-person worship!
