It's time for some long-overdue updates to our facilities. Property chair, Stephanie Drange, has done a wonderful job organizing contractors and projects. And we are ready to get stuff done this summer. Here is what is planned: about \$90.000 of "Phase One" - 1) Sanctuary carpet, lighting, and paint 2) New windows and redoing the parking lot. "Second Mile" projects totaling about \$27,000 - 1) Replacing the sanctuary projector and screen with high-definition televisions 2) New kitchen counters and cabinet doors 3) Painting the rest of the upstairs walls. Church council has identified \$80.000-90,000 of existing money to get started right away. We invite you to help us cross the finish line with the rest.
